

1. Paper Snowflake Collage or Window Lanterns

- **Materials**: paper (white & colored), vellum or translucent paper, scissors, glue, string, jars (for lanterns)
- How to do it: Cut snowflakes; layer them on translucent paper or vellum to create collage panels or lantern wraps. Wrap jars and place LED tealights inside for soft glow shadows.

2. Salt Painting / Crayon-Resist Snow Scenes

- Materials: white crayon, watercolor paints, salt
- How to do it: On white paper, draw snow scenes with white crayon (e.g. trees, hills).
 Paint over with watercolor; the crayon resists. While paint is wet, sprinkle salt to create frosty texture.

3. DIY Snow Globe / Mini Winter Worlds

- Materials: jars, water, glycerin (optional), glitter, small figurines or natural bits, glue
- **How to do it**: Mount small figurines or bits to the underside of the jar lid (glue). Fill jar with water, a bit of glycerin (to slow glitter fall), sprinkle glitter, seal well.
- Variation: create a felt or foam diorama inside a box or shallow tray with cotton "snow," sticks, miniature houses, etc.

4. Felt or Fabric Memory Ornaments

- Materials: felt or fabric scraps, embroidery floss or glue, beads, buttons
- **How to do it**: Cut shapes (trees, stars, mittens, hearts). Decorate with beads, stitch or glue. Each ornament can include a memory, note, or tiny drawing inside. Over time, build a "memory tree" of the year.

5. Shadow Puppet Winter Theater

- **Materials**: black paper or cardstock, sticks or skewers, scissors, tape, a light source, blank backdrop
- **How to do it**: Cut winter-themed puppet shapes (tree, deer, snowman, characters). Mount on sticks. Use a flashlight or lamp to cast shadows on a wall or sheet. Children and mom can improvise short stories or retell favorite winter tales.
